

ORDINANCE No. 79197

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to draw warrants on the General Fund to provide for the expense of the vacation of a portion of North Kilpatrick Street and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Council finds that Richard Talboy deposited with the City Treasurer the sum of \$15.00 to provide for the payment of expense on account of the vacation of a portion of North Kilpatrick street, which amount was placed to the credit of the General Fund; that the expense of advertising said vacation, which amounted to \$9.41, has been paid and charged to the General Fund; that the cost of recording the ordinance authorizing said vacation in the offices of the County Clerk and County Surveyor of Multnomah County is \$5.25, and there is due said Richard Talboy a refund of \$0.34; therefore, the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw a warrant on the General Fund chargeable to the appropriation Refunds (4700.665) payable to Richard Talboy in the amount of \$0.34, also additional warrant as follows on the General Fund chargeable to the office of City Auditor (3700.399) to provide for the expense of said vacation:

Clerk of Multnomah County, Recording.....\$2.75
Surveyor of Multnomah County, Recording.....\$2.50

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: The foregoing amounts authorized to be paid are due and should be paid without delay; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
