## ordinance no. 79956

An Ordinance amending Section 20-3101 of the License and Business Code (Ordinance No. 76298) so as to exempt from the license fee, all dogs honorably discharged from the Armed Forces of the United States.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section I. The Council finds that many of the patriotic citizens of Portland have given into the armed forces of the United States for service in battle their highly prized dogs, in many instances cherished family pets, and that such animals are performing valiant duty in the service of our country, with the result that many of them are killed or maimed in action.

The Council further finds that from time to time certain of these dogs, having done their bit, receive honorable discharge and are returned to their respective owners, and that as to such dogs it is fitting and proper that their owners be exempt from payment of the license fees generally exacted of the owners of dogs; now, therefore, Section 20-3101 of the License and Business Code (Ordinance 76398) be and the same hereby is amended to read as Tollows:

Section 20-3101. FEES. The license fees for dogs shall be:

Male or spayed female, annually \$2.00
Female not spayed, annually 3.00
Male or female for breeding purposes;
provided, breeder has at least five dogs
each, annually 1.00

License fees shall be paid on or before
September of each year. Licenses shall be granted
only for the year beginning September 1 and ending the
following August 31 for all dogs four months or more of
age; provided, that in case a dog attains the age of four
months or more of age; provided, that in case a dog
attains the age of four months after March 1, or is purchased
or is brought to the city after said date, the owner after
making affidavit of such fact, shall be required to pay
as follows: beginning March 1, w1.00 for a male dog,
and \$1.50 for a female dog. The bureau of licenses shall
give the licensee a numbered license tag upon payment of the
fee; provided, that in recognition of valorous service

faithfully performed, all dogs heretofore or hereafter receiving honorable discharge from the armed forces of the United States be, and their owners hereby are, exempted as to payment of the license fees hereinabove provided, and upon application and proof of such discharge such owners shall receive from the city free of charge, a distinctive license tag indicating that such dogs, as honorably discharged veterans, are licensed without fee.
