SUBJECT: Kids Experience Bull Run

This morning, we will hear from the Portland Water Bureau and students from the Boise-Eliot/Humboldt School about a new art exhibition recreating the magic of the Bull Run Watershed.

Every year, the Portland Water Bureau guides hundreds of students through the Bull Run to study water science and engineering.

Last fall, Boise-Eliot/Humboldt fourth graders were given a special mission during their visit: bring back the Bull Run experience to Portland through art.

The special tour was designed for these students to experience the watershed using their five senses – even taste. Students took a silent walk through the forest, recorded sound from inside a dam, practiced photo yoga, and tasted an oxalis plant. Upon returning to school, they created the artwork that is on display in the City Hall atrium.

The Bull Run Watershed is the envy of the nation, and the Water Bureau is proud to share access to this precious resource with young Portlanders.
