An Ordinance adopting the City Engineer's report made pursuant to Resolution No. 22385 for the proposed laying out and establishing of N.W. 26th Avenue, 60 feet in width, between N.W. Yeon Avenue and N.W. Front Avenue, in the City of Portland, Oregon.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The City Engineer's report filed with the City Auditor July 17, 1944, pursuant to Resolution No. 22365 for the proposed laying out and establishing of N.W. 26th Avenue, 60 feet in width, between N.W. Yeon Avenue and N.W. Front Avenue, in the City of Portland, Oregon, is hereby adopted, approved and confirmed, which report, omitting map attached, is in words and figures as follows:

Fortland, Oregon July 13, 1944

TO THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORTLAND, OREGON.

Centlemen:

Pursuant to Resolution No. 22385, adopted by
the Council June 15, 1944, directing me to make a
survey and plat of the opening of N.W. 26th Avenue, 60
feet in width, between N.W. Yeon Avenue and N.W. Front
Avenue, and a written report thereon as provided by the
City Charter; I have made such a survey and plat,
which plat is filed herewith and for ideatification is
marked "Map Showing property to be asquired in connection
with the opening of N.W. 25th Ave.," and I make this my
written report as follows:

DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY REQUIRED

A full description of such proposed opening is as follows:

Beginning at a point in Sec. 29, T.lN., R.lK., W.M.; at the most westerly corner of that tract of land conveyed by the City of Portland, a municipal corporation, to the Mastern & Western Lumber Co., an Oregon corporation and recorded in Book 685 at Page 104 of Photostatic Deed Records of Multnomen County, Oregon, which point is in the northeasterly line of M.W. Yoon Avenue; thence North 29 degrees 48 minutes 30 seconds East along the westerly line of said tract and its northeasterly projection a distance of 876.37 feet to a point on the southwesterly line of N.W. Front Avenue: thence North 48 degrees 44 minutes 20 seconds West along the southwesterly line of N.W. Front Avenue a distance of Q.22 feet to a point which is 60 feet distant from first mentioned course when measured at right angles thereto; thence South 29 degrees 48 minutes 50 seconds West 894.78 feet to an intersection with the northeasterly line of N.W. Your Avenue; thense South 66 degrees 08 minutes East along the mortheasterly line of N.W. Youn Avenue 60.38 foot to the place of beginning.

Beginning at a point in Sec. 29, T.IN., R.IE., W.M.; at the most westerly corner of that tract of land conveyed by the City of Portland, a municipal corporation, to the Eastern & Western Lumber Co., an Oregon corporation and recorded in Book 683 at Page 104 of Photostatic Deed Records of Multnomah County, Oregon, which point is in the northeasterly line of N.W. Teon Avenue; thence North 29 degrees 48 minutes 30 seconds east along the westerly line of said tract, 601.01 feet to the southerly right of way line of the Northern Pacific Railway; thence North 48 degrees 44 minutes 20 seconds west along said right of way line 61.22 feet; thence South 29 degrees 48 minutes 30 seconds West, 619.42 feet to the northeasterly line of N.W. Yeon Avenue; thence South 66 degrees 08 minutes East along said northeasterly line 60.32 feet to the place of beginning; containing 0.84 acres.

The foregoing percel is all of a tract of land herein designated as Tract No. 1.

of Multnomah County, Oregon, which point is in the northeasterly line of N.W. Yeon Avenue; thence North 29

degrees 48 minutes 30 seconds East along the westerly line
of said tract, 601.01 feet to the southwesterly line of
the Northern Pacific Railway Co. Right of Way, said point
being the true point of beginning of this description; thence
North 48 degrees 44 minutes 20 seconds west along the southwesterly line of said Right of Way 61.22 feet; thence
North 29 degrees 48 minutes 30 seconds East, 71.42 feet to
the northeasterly line of the Northern Pacific Railway Co.
Right of Way; thence South 48 degrees 44 minutes 20 seconds
East along the northeasterly line of said Right of Way
61.22 feet; thence South 29 degrees 48 minutes 30 seconds
West 71.42 feet to point of beginning; containing 0.13
acres.

Yeon Avenue; thence North 29

degrees 48 minutes 30 seconds East, 672.45 feet to the northeasterly line of the Northern Pacific Railway Right of Way, said point being the true point of beginning of this description; thence North 46 degrees 44 minutes 20 seconds East along the northeasterly line of said Right of Way 61.22 feet; thence North 29 degrees 48 minutes 30 seconds East, 203.94 feet to the southwesterly line of N.W. Front Avenue; thence South 48 degrees 44 minutes 80 seconds East along the southwesterly line of N.W. Front Avenue, 20,99 feet to the westerly line of the Oregon Terminals. Inc. 20-foot spur track right of way: thence South 29 degrees 45 minutes West along said right of way 23.50 feet to a point of tengency with a curve to the left, having a radius of 850.5 feet; thence southerly on such curve a distance of 142.18 feet to an intersection with the easterly line of the new street herein proposed: thence South 29 degrees 48 minutes 30 seconds west, 55.33 feet to point of beginning; containing 0.181 acres.

TRACT NO. S. PARCEL "B":

Commonding at a point in Sec. 89, T.IN., R.IE., W.M., at the most westerly corner of that track of land conveyed by the city of Portland, a municipal corporation, to the Eastern & Western Elmber Co.. an Oregon corporation and recorded in Book 683 at Page 104 c? Photostatic Deed Records of Multnemah County, Oregon, which point is in the

northeasterly line of N.W. Yeon Avenue; thence North 29
degrees 48 minutes 30 seconds East along the westerly line
of said tract of land and its northeasterly extension,
876.37 feet to the southwesterly line of N.W. Front Avenue;
thence North 48 degrees 44 minutes 20 seconds West along
the southwesterly line of N.W. Front Avenue 19.38 feet to
the easterly line of Oregon Terminals, Inc. spur track right
of way; thence South 29 degrees 45 minutes West along the said
easterly right of way line 19.44 feet to a tangent point of a
ourve to the left with a radius of 230.5 feet; thence southerly
along said curve 95.05 feet to an intersection with the
easterly line of the new street herein proposed; thence North
29 degrees 48 minutes 30 seconds East, 108.32 feet to point
of beginning; containing .037 acres.

Yoon Avenue; thence North 89 degrees 48 minutes 50 seconds East along the west line of said tract of

land and its northeasterly extension 876.37 feet to the southwesterly line of N.W. Front Avenue; thence North 48 degrees 44 minutes 20 seconds West along the southwesterly line of N.W. Front Avenue 40.25 feet to the westerly line of the Oregon Terminals. Inc. spur track right of way. said point being the true place of beginning of this description: thence South 29 degrees 45 minutes West along said westerly right of way line, 23.50 feet to a point of tangency with a curve to the left, having a radius of 250.5 feet: thence Southerly along said curve a distance of 142.18 feet to an intersection with the easterly line of the new street herein proposed: thence North 29 degrees 48 minutes 30 seconds East, 42.20 feet to a point in the easterly right of way of said spur track and 20 feet distant from the westerly right of way line of said spur track, when measured on a radial line; thence northerly on a curve to the right with a radius of 250.5 feet and along the easterly right of way line of said spur track, a distence of 95.05 feet; thence North 29 degrees 45 minutes Bast along said easterly right of way line 19.44 feet to an intersection with the southwesterly line of N.W. Front Avenue; thence North 46 degrees 44 minutes 30 seconds West along the southwesterly line of N.W. Front Avenue, 20.40 feet to the place of beginning; containing 0.65 acres.

In case any additional taxes, city liens or other claims come against the property before the damages awarded or otherwise discharged, awarded are collected and are ready for payment, such additional taxes, liens or other claims shall be deducted from the amount of damages awarded or otherwise discharged. The column headed "Damages sustained" embraces the value of land taken, including buildings and improvements, if any, the damages, if any, to the residue.

No assessment of benefits to a local district is contemplated in this report, therefore no assessment district is herein described.
