Nothing contained herein or in said proceedings shall be taken as appropriating or affecting the right of way of the Northern Pacific Reilway Company to use for railroad purposes the portion of said property heretofore used and embraced in its right of mey, it being intended hereby that this portion of said property shall be used concurrently for street purposes and railroad purposes; and nothing contained herein shall be deemed or taken as appropriating or affecting the right of the Northern Pacific Terminal Company to use for railroad terminal purposes the portion of said property heretofore used and embraced in its terminal right, it being intended hereby that this portion of said property shall be used concurrently for street purposes and railroad terminal Durdoses.
