An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Commissioner of Public Works to enter into agreements with certain railroad companies for the construction of a crossing over their right of ways at N.W. Kittridge avenue between N.W. Yeon avenue and N.W. Front avenue, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. It appearing to the Council that the use by the public of N.W. Kittridge avenue is of little value without a connection across railroad companies' right of ways between N.W. Front avenue and N.W. Yeon avenue, and in consequence of which arrangements have been made for an overhead crossing as herein provided; now, therefore, the Mayor and Commissioner of Public Works are hereby authorized on behalf of the Council (1) to execute agreements with the railroad companies affected pertaining to such overhead structure across the tracks of said railroad companies at N.W. Kittridge avenue, and (2) and to enter into a contract with L. H. Hoffman for the construction of said overhead crossing; said agreements to be in substantial accord with the form of agreements and exhibits attached to and accompanying a report by the Commissioner of Public Works filed with the Auditor on March 1, 1945, and designated as council calendar No. 804, and to be approved as to form by the City Attorney, and the said contract to be in the usual form, approved by the City Attorney and applicable to the plans and specifications upon which bids were recently received and the contract awarded to said L. H. Hoffman.

Section 2. The Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized and directed to deliver warrants in payment for said contract work as payments become due in accordance with the specifications and contract; said warrants to be against and made chargeable to the General Fund appropriation Kittridge Avenue Viaduct - 6735.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland: That the dangers existing at said crossing should be removed without unnecessary delay; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
