

ORDINANCE NO. 82035

An Ordinance providing for the dedication of N.W. Lomita Lane, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. It appearing to the Council that city maps have been made showing a public lane designated as N.W. Lomita Lane, in Lots 1, 2 and 4 and parts of Lots 3 and 10 of Block 15, King's Heights; that steps were taken to dedicate said lane although a dedication was not completed but certain properties were sold with reference to such lane; that a recent investigation by the City Attorney has resulted in a report that the area shown in said lane is street area by implied dedication notwithstanding the lack of a formal dedication; that the location of said lane should be definitely shown and therefore a formal dedication and map should be made and recorded; now, therefore, the Mayor and Commissioner of Finance are hereby authorized on behalf of the City to execute a suitable instrument approved by the City Attorney as to form formally making said dedication to the public and showing by an accompanying plat the location of said street area.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: That uncertainty about matters like the above should be remedied without delay; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
