

ORDINANCE NO. 82059

An Ordinance transferring \$100.00 from Personal Service and \$100.00 from Operation and Maintenance to the Appropriation, Equipment; all within the Office of the Commissioner of Public Utilities, authorizing the drawing of warrants, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Council finds that due to the increased activities in connection with Traffic Control, it is necessary to purchase additional office furniture. The Council further finds that no provision was made in the budget for the fiscal year 1945-1946 for the purchase of equipment in the Office of the Commissioner of Public Utilities; now, therefore, the sum of \$100.00 be and the same is hereby transferred from the Appropriation, Office of the Commissioner of Public Utilities, Personal Service, (2300.110), and a further transfer of \$100.00 from the Office of Commissioner of Public Utilities, Operation and Maintenance (2300), to the Appropriation, Office of Commissioner of Public Utilities, Equipment (2300.720).

That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized to draw warrants on said Appropriation when demands therefor are presented, approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of The City of Portland in this: In order that there may be no unnecessary delay in providing authority for the purchase of equipment in the Office of Commissioner of Public Utilities; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
