## ordinance no. 82437

An Ordinance amending section 20-2908 of the License and Business Code (Orlinance No. 76398) so as to allow proprietors of amusement parks of certain area to permit dancing on Sundays under certain restrictions, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. It appearing to the Council that dances may properly be held as herein provided during Sunday hours in amusement parks containing 20 or more acres and having a suitable hall or floor for dancing; now, therefore, section 20-2908 of the License and Business Code (Ordinance No. 76398) is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 20-2908. TIME FOR HOLDING DANCES. No person shall hold or participate in any dence as defined in this article on any Sunday, which for the purpose of this article is hereby defined to be the period of time between 1:00 a.m., Sunday, and 7:00 a.m. of the following Monday. All dances shall be discontinued and all dance halls be closed between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. of Nothing contained herein shall each week day. prevent dancing within said hours in cases where the place of dancing is on a suitable floor in an amusement park containing 20 or more acres, which park is operated under license as provided in article 11 of this ordinance; provided, that such dancing is conducted under the general supervision of the amusement park proprietor and under the special supervision of an organization holding a picnic within said park when and as such picnic fells on a Sunday, but this provision shall not relax the other provisions of article 29 of this code or allow dancing on Sunday under the auspices of any organization which is not known to conduct its activities in an orderly and decent manner.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: That the season for picnics is now at hand and the holding of picnics within the city limits as above provided should not be unduly restricted; therefore,

an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
