## ORDINANCE NO. 18757?

\* Amend contract with Transition Projects to add \$450,000 for the operation of a six-month emergency shelter for men experiencing homelessness (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 32001169)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that:

- 1. As part of the City of Portland's declared State of Emergency for housing and homelessness, the Portland City Council is investing \$450,000 in City General Funds to open a six-month additional emergency shelter for men experiencing homelessness with priority for Veterans, men over the age of 55 and those with disabilities. The program aligns with strategies identified in *A Home for Everyone: A United Community Plan to End Homelessness in Multnomah County*.
- 2. The City of Portland, acting through its Portland Housing Bureau (PHB), has been the primary funder of key strategies and services of *A Home for Everyone* and the State of Emergency.
- 3. PHB desires to amend the existing Contract No. 32001169 to add \$450,000 to fund the proposed program.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs that:

- a. The Bureau Director is hereby authorized to enter into a contract amendment with Transition Projects in a form similar to the amendment attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Portland Housing Bureau's operating fund budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in implementing the authorized amendment and associated program would place people experiencing homelessness at increased risk of illness or injury. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
