ORDINANCE No. 90433

An Ordinance authorizing the Commissioner of Public Works and Auditor to draw a warrant on the Sewage Disposal Fund to Mary N. and H.N. Brooks for certain property required for the interceptor of the Portland Sewage Disposal System, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Council finds that the City Engineer has received in trust a certain warranty deed for the interceptor of the Portland Sewage Disposal System for the consideration herein stated:

> Mary M. Brooks and H.M. Brooks - - - - - - \$87.23 A portion of Lot 3, Block 8, Subdivision in Froebstel's Addition to Albina

That the City Engineer has advised that said purchase price is reasonable for said deed and payment should be made; now, therefore, the Commissioner of Fublic Works and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized to draw and deliver a warrant in favor of the above-mamed persons, in the amount shown, in payment for the above described property, following examination of title report as to said property and approval thereof by the City Attorney.

Said warrant shall be chargeable to the Sewage Disposal Fund, 6350.790.

Section 2. Inazzuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the dity of Portland in this: said property is necessary for the construction of the Sewage Disposal System and should be obtained without undue delay; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
