An Ordinance accepting a sewer easement for the NE 122nd Avenue Interceptor Sewer Project, granted by James Sodaro and Beulah Sodaro, authorizing total payment of \$3180.00, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- Right of way is required for construction of the NE 122nd Avenue Interceptor Sewer Project.
- James Sodaro and Beulah Sodaro have conveyed the required right of way to the City for the total sum of \$3,180.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the following described easement is hereby accepted for sewer purposes:

R/W #4044-4

The north 15.0 feet of the east 120 feet of Lot 10, Ascot Acres, in the County of Multnomah and State of Oregon

Together with a temporary construction easement for the original construction of the NE Couch Street to NE 133rd Avenue Sewer Project, described as follows:

The south 20.0 feet of the north 35.0 feet of the east 50.0 feet of Lot 10, Ascot Acres; and also, the south 20.0 feet of the north 35.0 feet of the west 15.0 feet of the east 120.0 feet of Lot 10, Ascot Acres, all in the County of Multnomah and State of Oregon.

It is understood and agreed that the temporary construction easement shall terminate upon completion of the NE Couch Street to NE 133rd Avenue Sewer Project.

b. The Mayor and Auditor to draw and deliver a warrant in payment for the above described easement in the amount and in favor of the following:

Grantor: James Sodaro and Beulah Sodaro Amount: \$3,180.00

Portland OR 97220

said warrant to be charged to the Sewage Disposal Fund, BUC 17200046, Project 4142.

ORDINANCE No.

- The Auditor shall record in the appropriate deed records, documents of title as necessary for purchase of this right of way, and return one copy of each recorded document to the Right of Way Acquisition Section, Bureau of Transportation Engineering.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in the acceptance of the sewer easement might result in delays in construction of the sewer; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
