

# ORDINANCE No. 97232

An Ordinance authorizing the drawing and delivery of a warrant in the sum of \$25.00 as a reward to J. A. Frethiem, 1952 S. W. Third Avenue, Portland, Oregon, for the finding and returning of a City-owned Sheeting Driver which had been lost, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Council finds that on or about August 19, 1952, a Worthington Pump and Machinery Corporation Sheeting Driver, Inventory No. 25267, belonging to the City of Portland, Department of Public Works, was lost off a City-owned truck and the same was found by J. A. Frethiem who returned the said Sheeting Driver to the Department of Public Works; that he should be compensated in the sum of \$25.00 as a reward; now, therefore, the Mayor and Auditor hereby are authorized and directed to draw and deliver a warrant in the sum of \$25.00 payable to said J. A. Frethiem as a reward for the return of the Sheeting Driver as above mentioned, said warrant to be drawn against and charged to the General Fund Appropriation, Rewards (4775).

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: in order that all financial obligations of the City may be promptly discharged; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
