ORDINANCE No. 99284

An Ordinance designating and assigning as street area, for the widening of N.E. Broadway in Eastgate Village, a certain tract of land now owned by the City of Portland, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. It appearing to the Council that certain property, as hereinafter described, has been acquired by the City of Portland for the widening of W.E. broadway between W.E. 36th Avenue and the turnaround in Blocks 5 and 6, Rastgate Village in the City of Portland, but this parcel of property has not as yet been officially designated and assigned street area, and the Council being of the opinion that such designation and assignment should be made without delay; now, therefore, the following described parcel is hereby designated and assigned to the use aforesaid. Said parcel of land to be used for the purposes herein mentioned is more particularly described as follows:

All of that part of Lot 12, Block 9, Railway Addition, and Lot 14, Block 5, Eastgate Village, northerly and easterly of the following described line:

Beginning at a point in the north line of Lot 12, Block 9, Railway Addition, which point is 3.0 feet east of the northwest corner of said Lot 12; thence southeasterly, parallel to and 50 feet distant from the northeasterly line of N.E. Broadway adjacent to Lot 1, Block 6, Eastgate Village, when measured at right angles thereto, to a point in the east line of Lot 12 79.98 feet north of the scuthcast corner thereof; thence continuing southeasterly, parallel to and 50 feet distant from the northeasterly line of N.E. Broadway, through Lot 14, Block 5, Eastgate Village to a point in the westerly line of the turnsround in N.E. Broadway in Blocks 5 and 6, Eastgate Village, in the City of Portland, County of Multnomeh, Oregon.

Section 2. That the City Auditor be and he is hereby directed to have a cortifica copy of this ordinance placed on record and a copy of said ordinance forwarded to the County Assessor.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, reace and safety of the City of Portland in this: The use of said property for street purposes is needed without delay; therefore, an omergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
