

ORDINANCE No. 100674

An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Purchasing Agent to advertise and receive proposals for furnishing One Diesel-Powered Track-Laying Tractor with Angle Dozer and Towing Winch for the Bureau of Water Works, authorizing a contract therefor, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Purchasing Agent be and he hereby is authorized and directed to advertise and receive proposals for the furnishing of One Diesel-Powered Track-Laying Tractor with Angle Dozer and Towing Winch for the Bureau of Water Works, Department of Public Utilities, in strict accordance with the specifications therefor filed in the office of the Bureau of Purchases on June 25, 1954, which specifications hereby are adopted and by reference made a part of this ordinance.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Commissioner of Public Utilities be and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the furnishing of said Angle Dozer to said Bureau of Water Works, and the Council hereby is authorized to reject any and all bids which it deems to be unsatisfactory, and in the event no satisfactory bids are received, the Purchasing Agent be and he hereby is authorized to readvertise therefor until a satisfactory bid is received. The warrant in payment of said equipment shall be chargeable to the appropriation Water Construction Fund, Equipment (5900.720).

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: in order that there may be no unnecessary delay in providing authority for the furnishing of the aforesaid equipment which is urgently needed; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
