ORDINANCE No. 187652

*Accept a grant in the amount of \$2,009,953 from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the Downtown I-405 Ped Safety & Operational Improvements Project and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland Bureau of Transportation applied to ODOT for a grant in the amount of \$2,009,953.00 for the Downtown I-405 Ped Safety & Operational Improvements Project in 2013.
- 2. The Downtown I-405 Ped Safety & Operational Improvements Project will design and constructing various operational and roadside improvements, including new curb ramps, marked crosswalks, signal upgrades and connectivity improvements.
- 3. The Oregon Department of Transportation has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the Downtown I-405 Ped Safety & Operational Improvements in the amount of \$2,009,953.00. Portland Bureau of Transportation will provide the City's required matching amount of \$230,047.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the Downtown I-405 Ped Safety & Operational Improvements Project in the amount of \$2,009,953.00 and to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. This is budgeted in FY15-16 with grant fund 217001 and grant ID TR000174.
- c. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute amendments, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to the scope of the services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the City's financial risk. Increases to the grant amount must be approved by the City Council.
- d. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Commissioner-in-Charge's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
