An Ordinance authorizing the purchase of Lot 1, Block 55, Portland City Homestead, located at S.W. 14th and Curry, from O. A. Pitman, Jr., and Suzanne L. Pitman, for the sum of \$1,800.00, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Council finds that it is necessary and desirable for the Bureau of Water Works to purchase Lot 1, Block 55, Portland City Homestead, located at S.W. 14th and Curry, for the Marquam Hill Standpipe No. 2; that the property is presently owned by O. A. Pitman, Jr., and Suzanne L.
