

ORDINANCE NO. 118064

An Ordinance amending Sections 3-1104 and 3-1107 of Ordinance No. 77780, the Administration Code, reducing the membership on the Zoo Commission, reducing the number required for a quorum, providing for a meeting of new appointees, providing for termination of the terms of present Zoo Commission members, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that a report of the Commissioner of Finance was adopted February 5, 1964 which recommended that the Zoo Commission be reduced to nine members; that consistent with this recommendation the Zoo Commission membership provided for in Section 3-1104 of Ordinance No. 77780, the Administration Code, should be amended to show said reduction and Section 3-1107 of said code should be amended to reduce the number required for a quorum; and that provision should be made for a meeting of the new Commission appointees and for a reduction of the terms of present Zoo Commission members, as hereinafter set forth; now, therefore, Section 3-1104 of Ordinance No. 77780, the Administration Code, passed by the Council September 3, 1942, as amended, hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 3-1104. CREATION OF ZOO COMMISSION.

There hereby is created a zoo commission consisting of 9 voting members who shall serve without compensation. The commissioner in charge of the Bureau of Parks and the Commissioner of Finance shall be ex officio members not entitled to vote. The Mayor shall appoint the members of the commission, at least one of whom shall be a naturalist, from among representative members of the general public. Three members shall serve until January 1, 1965, three members shall serve until January 1, 1966, and three members shall serve until January 1, 1967. After expiration of the initial term of each member, the mayor shall appoint a successor for a term of three years. Upon the death, resignation or inability to serve of any member, the Mayor shall appoint a successor to fill out the unexpired term of that member. All members shall continue to serve until their successors have been appointed and qualified.

Section 2. Section 3-1107 of Ordinance No. 77780, the Administration Code, passed by the Council September 3, 1942, as amended, hereby is amended to read as follows:


Section 3-1107. QUORUM. A majority of votes of all members shall constitute a quorum at any regular meeting of the commission. Each of said members present at each regular and special meeting shall be entitled to one vote.

Section 3. For the purpose of implementing reorganization of the Zoo Commission as provided under Section 1 of this ordinance, within 15 days after the effective date of this ordinance, the Mayor shall appoint nine voting members to the Zoo Commission, three to serve until January 1, 1965, three to serve until January 1, 1966, and three to serve until January 1, 1967. A list of these appointees shall be given the commissioner in charge of the Bureau of Parks, who shall call a meeting of the Zoo Commission within 45 days after the effective date of this ordinance to elect from the membership a chairman and vice-chairman. Written notice of the time and place thereof shall be sent to the appointees by the commissioner at least 5 days before the date of said meeting.


Section 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 3-1104 of Ordinance No. 77780, the Administration Code, the terms of the voting membership of the Zoo Commission, as constituted upon the effective date of this ordinance shall terminate on the day immediately preceding the date fixed for a meeting of the Zoo Commission by the commissioner in charge of the Bureau of Parks under Section 3 of this ordinance. Terms of the voting members appointed under Section 3 of this ordinance shall commence the day of said meeting.

Section 5. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that a reduction in the membership of the Zoo Commission under the foregoing sections of this ordinance may be effected without unnecessary delay; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
