

## ORDINANCE NO. 119879

#### An Ordinance amending Section 2 of Ordinance No. 113985 which provided for purchase of a tract of land and buildings from Buren L. Kays and Minnie Kays and Harry L. Yager and Bess Yager to provide a substitute method of payment of the purchase price, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that Ordinance No. 118985 authorized purchase of a tract of land and buildings thereon in Section 24, TIS, RIE., W. M., Multnomah County from Buren L. Kays and Minnie Kays, husband and wife, and Harry L. Yager and Bess Yager, husband and wife, for the sum of \$23,700; that Section 2 of said ordinance provided for the drawing and delivery of separate warrants in payment to the sellers for title insurance and for revenue stamps; that the sellers have requested that the total purchase price be made payable to Pacific Title Insurance Company in lieu of payment of the purchase price, title insurance and revenue stamps as specified in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 118985; now, therefore, Ordinance No. 118985 passed by the Council August 6, 1964, hereby is amended by deleting therefrom Section 2 in its entirety and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

"Section 2. The Mayor and Auditor are authorized and directed to draw and deliver a warrant in the sum of \$23,700 payable to Pacific Title Insurance Company, 315 S. W. 4th Avenue, Portland 4, Oregon, as payment of the purchase price, title insurance and revenue stamps, which warrant shall be charged to the State Tax Street Fund, Appropriation Land (6675.780). Such warrant shall be delivered at such time as the city shall receive a good and sufficient deed to the property to be conveyed and shall have also received an authorization approved as to form by the City Attorney from the sellers authorizing delivery of the purchase price to the Pacific Title Insurance Company in lieu of delivery to said sellers."

Section 2. Except as herein amended all other provisions of Ordinance No. 118985 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the

immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that this amendment of Ordinance No. 118985 may become effective without unnecessary delay; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


