ORDINANCE NO. 119255

An Ordinance authorizing rental of the Public Auditorium to the Portland Symphonic Choir by W. E. Nulton, on November 7, 1964 and February 27, 1965, at a reduced rental, under certain conditions, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that the Portland Symphonic Choir, by W. E. Nulton, Chairman of the Board, 6634 S.E. 39th Avenue, Portland 2, has requested use of the Public Auditorium for two concerts on November 7, 1964 and February 27, 1965 at a reduced rental; that the group is a local non-profit corporation and a cultural asset to the community; that it is in the public interest to grant this request; now, therefore, the Portland Symphonic Choir by W. E. Nulton, hereby is granted permission to rent the Public Auditorium on November 7, 1964, and February 27, 1965, at a reduced rental of \$225.00 for each date for the purpose of presenting concerts, subject to the following conditions:

(a) The reduced rental shall include usual lighting, heating and janitorial service, but shall not include the cost of stagehands, musicians, ticket sellers, reserve seat tickets, ushers, head ushers, doormen, public address system, additional lighting and heating, personal services, overtime or any other incidental expenses, all of which shall be paid for by the aforesaid organization.

(b) If the wings are used by the renter, the charge shall be \$50.00 plus the cost of setting up seats for each wing, in addition to the reduced rental of \$225.00 for each date.


Section 2. This ordinance shall be of no effect until the Portland Symphonic Choir by W.E. Nulton, Chairman of the Board, shall file with the Auditor in a form approved by the City Attorney, an acceptance of the terms and conditions of this ordinance.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that


