

## ORDINANCE NO. 119866

An Ordinance transferring a total of \$35,714 within the General Fund from the special appropriation for the replacement of motor vehicle equipment, and from budget contingencies to the appropriations of the bureaus which have been allocated replacement trucks and tractors, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that an appropriation of \$100,000 is provided in the current budget for the replacement of motor vehicle equipment; that replacements are to be based upon the recommendation of the City Shop Superintendent; that the City Shop Superintendent has made his recommendation; that by Ordinance No. 119612, passed December 23, 1964, \$66,207.82 has been transferred to the bureaus which were authorized replacement automobiles; that it is now necessary to transfer funds to the bureaus for replacement trucks and tractors; that the cost of such trucks and tractors is \$35,714; that \$33,792.18 will be provided from the remainder of the special appropriation for the replacement of motor vehicle equipment and \$1,921.82 should be provided from Budget Contingencies; now, therefore, the sum of \$35,714 is hereby transferred within the General Fund for replacement of trucks and tractors as follows:



## ORDINANCE No.


