

ORDINANCE NO. 123394

An Ordinance granting authority to the Bureau of Water Works to locate, construct and perpetually maintain a 5.6 million gallon capacity steel reservoir at a certain location in Forest Park, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that in order to meet increasing demands for water it is necessary to add storage capacity to the reservoir system in the northwest part of the city; that the Chief Engineer of the Bureau of Water Works has proposed that a 5.6 million gallon capacity welded steel reservoir, to be known as Mayfair Reservoir, be constructed in this area and has requested permission to locate it on Park Bureau property at a certain location in Forest Park; that the Superintendent of Parks and the Commissioner in charge of the Bureau of Parks have approved the construction of the proposed reservoir at the site requested; that this proposed improvement will not unduly interfere with recreational use of this property by the public and it is in the public interest to build the reservoir on the site requested; now, therefore, authority hereby is granted to the Bureau of Water Works to construct and perpetually maintain a 5.6 million gallon capacity reservoir together with all utility connections reasonably necessary for the use of the same at a certain location in Forest Park described as follows:

A parcel of land being part of Lot 46 and Lot 47, Blythswood, as situated in Section 30, T1N., R1E., Willamette Meridian, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 54 of the above-described Blythswood;

Thence South  $14^{\circ} 57'$  West along the southerly extension of the Westerly boundary of said Lot 54, a distance of 20 feet to the intersection of the center-line of Mayfair Avenue;

Thence North  $88^{\circ} 15'$  West 130.25 feet to a radius point;

Thence South  $49^{\circ} 00'$  East, a distance of 110 feet to the true point of beginning;

Thence along a curve to the right traced from the above-described radius point through a central angle of  $275^{\circ} 45'$ , a distance of 264.71 feet;

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Thence North 46° 45' East, a distance of 60 feet;

Thence South 28° 03' East 55 feet more or less to the northwesterly boundary of Lot 54, of said Blythswood;

Thence South 14° 57' West along the northwesterly boundary of said Lot 54 to a point that lies South 14° 57' West 20 feet from the Southwest corner of said Lot 54;

Thence South 34° 40' West, a distance of 82.91 feet to the true point of beginning heretofore described as being South 49° 00' East 110 feet from the above-mentioned radius point.


LESS that portion within N.W. Mayfair Avenue.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that there be no unnecessary delay in meeting the water demands of the city, therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
