

**IMPACT STATEMENT**

**Legislation title:** \*Pay claim of Adrian Reyes Cruz in the sum of \$33,418 involving the Portland Police Bureau. (Ordinance)

**Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:**

This Ordinance settles a bodily injury and property damage claim brought by Adrian Reyes Cruz and his automobile insurer, Geico Insurance, for injuries and car damage from an automobile collision. The collision occurred on December 13, 2014, at the intersection of NE Halsey Street and NE 102nd Avenue. Mr. Cruz was driving eastbound on NE Halsey, and collided with a Portland Police Bureau vehicle that was southbound on NE 102nd.

**Financial and budgetary impacts:**

This legislation will have no impact on City revenue.

Total cost to the City to settle the claim is \$33,417.86. The source of funding is the City's Insurance and Claims Fund. All cost of the settlement is in the current fiscal year. This Ordinance does not amend the budget.

**Community impacts and community involvement:**

This Ordinance settles a tort claim resulting from an automobile collision involving a City driver. No public involvement or input was sought regarding this Ordinance. The City Attorney's Office and Risk Management have concluded that it is not appropriate to have public involvement in settlement negotiations regarding tort claims or lawsuits against the City.

No future public involvement is anticipated or necessary. Approval by City Council of this Ordinance will fully settle a tort claim against the City of Portland.
