Dear Council Colleagues,

As Commissioner-in-charge of the Bureau of Transportation, it is with great enthusiasm that I request your confirmation to appoint the final three members, and the replacement committee representative for the Port of Portland, Private For-Hire Transportation Advisory Committee.

The City of Portland's Private For-Hire Transportation (PFHT) program within the Bureau of Transportation provides regulatory oversight for the safe, fair and efficient operation of for-hire transportation services. Service operators include taxi companies, Transportation Network Companies (TNCs), limousine and party bus companies, executive town cars, tour operators, pedicabs, non-emergency medical transportation (NEMT) companies and horse drawn carriages.

The PFHT Advisory Committee was established by Portland City Council in December 2015 to provide expertise and feedback to the public, PBOT Director and City Council on Portland's PFHT market, regulations and polices, taking into consideration the full range of City goals and objectives. The Committee consists of nineteen diverse members with expertise, knowledge and interest in for-hire transportation in the City of Portland. On January 27, 2016, Council appointed seventeen representatives to the Committee. The appointed Taxi Driver representative vacated his seat and PBOT conducted targeted outreach to taxi drivers, as well as to executive town car and shuttle drivers, to solicit applicants to the Committee. The attached list of nominees is hereby presented to Council for consideration of appointment to the PFHT Advisory Committee.
