Dear City of Portland Auditor,

My name is Peter Tetrick, and I'm a former part-time seasonal City of Portland employee. I would like to testify before City Council regarding the Part-time seasonal employees for the Bureau of Parks and Recreation. Although I'm not currently employed by the City of Portland, I would say that the classification of part-time seasonal employee is quite inaccurate. PP & R has increasingly relied on part-time employees to actually run facilities and Community Center operations/programs. Managers and unionized employees make about 3-10 times what a seasonal employee makes. Also, how the 1200 hr maximum for seasonal employees actually ends up causing the City of Portland to lose money. I would like to know who I should reach out to, to make that happen.


