

Ordinance No. **23783**

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Auditor, on behalf of the City of Portland, to enter into contract with the Washington Oregon Railroad and Navigation Company for a certain right-of-way and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance No. **23783**

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Auditor, on behalf of the City of Portland, be and they are hereby authorized to enter into contract with the Washington Oregon Railroad and Navigation Company, for a period of two years, for a right-of-way upon which to construct a sidewalk and stairway from the west end of Wood Street in a southerly direction to a point on the County Road providing the cost of said right-of-way shall not exceed One Dollar (\$1.00) per annum.

Section 2: Whereas there is an immediate necessity that this Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval by the Mayor an emergency is hereby declared and said ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Portland for the following reasons: It is necessary for the safety of the people residing in the vicinity of said right-of-way that said contract be entered into immediately. Therefore this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its approval by the Mayor.
