Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The Portland Housing Bureau (PHB) will submit a grant application to the Metro for their Equitable Housing Planning and Development Grants Program. The application seeks to fund predevelopment work on the Terminal 1 site to determine feasibility of the Oregon Trail to Hope project including site and financial feasibility assessments for proposed programmatic uses.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

Successful application would result in grant income of \$100,000, and would be reflected in the FY 2016/17 PHB budget.

This grant requires a 10% match of awarded funds, requiring \$10,000 in match for the requested \$100,000 in grant funds. PHB will satisfy the match requirement through salary, benefits, and material and services within its FY 2016/17 budget. No new budget requests or adjustments are required.

Community impacts and community involvement:

None. Community involvement will be included within program design if PHB is awarded the grant and the project moves forward in development.
